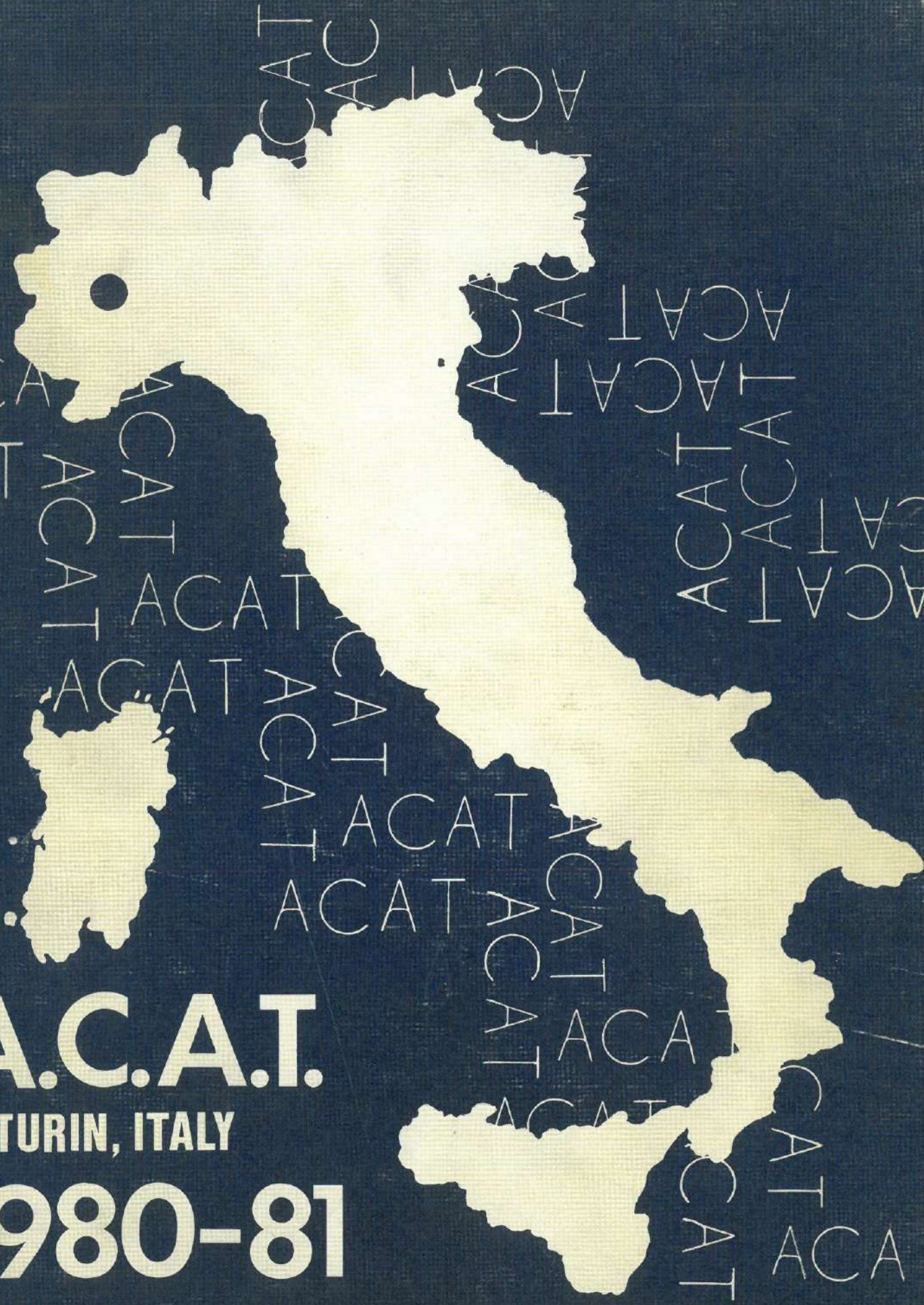
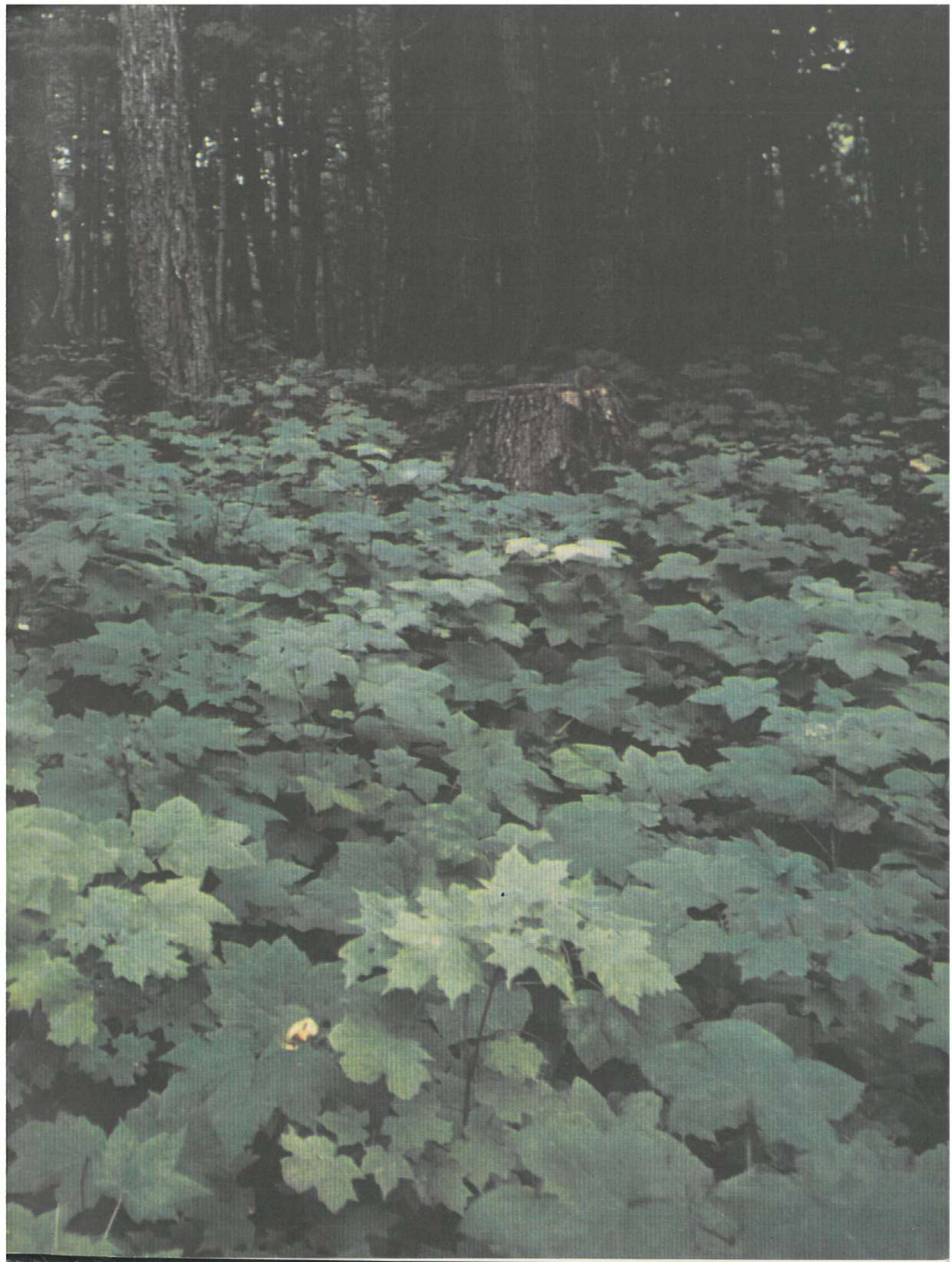

We've each a darkening hill to climb;

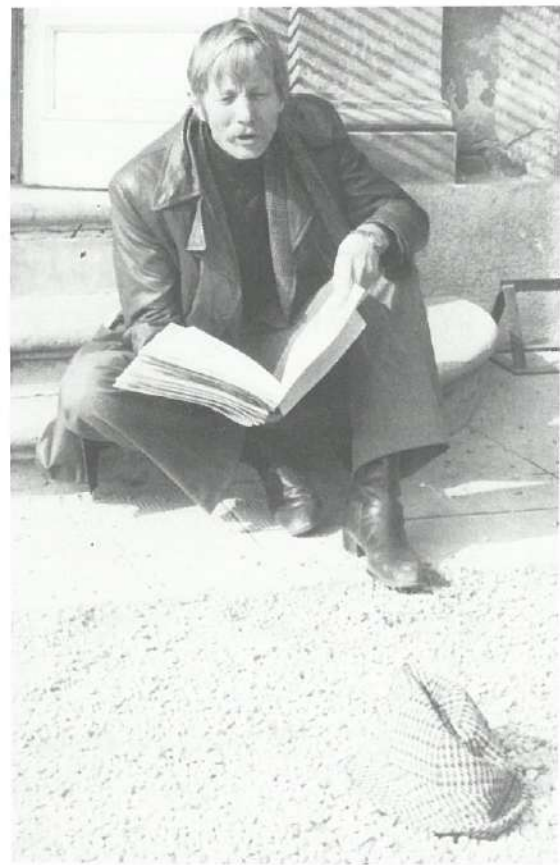
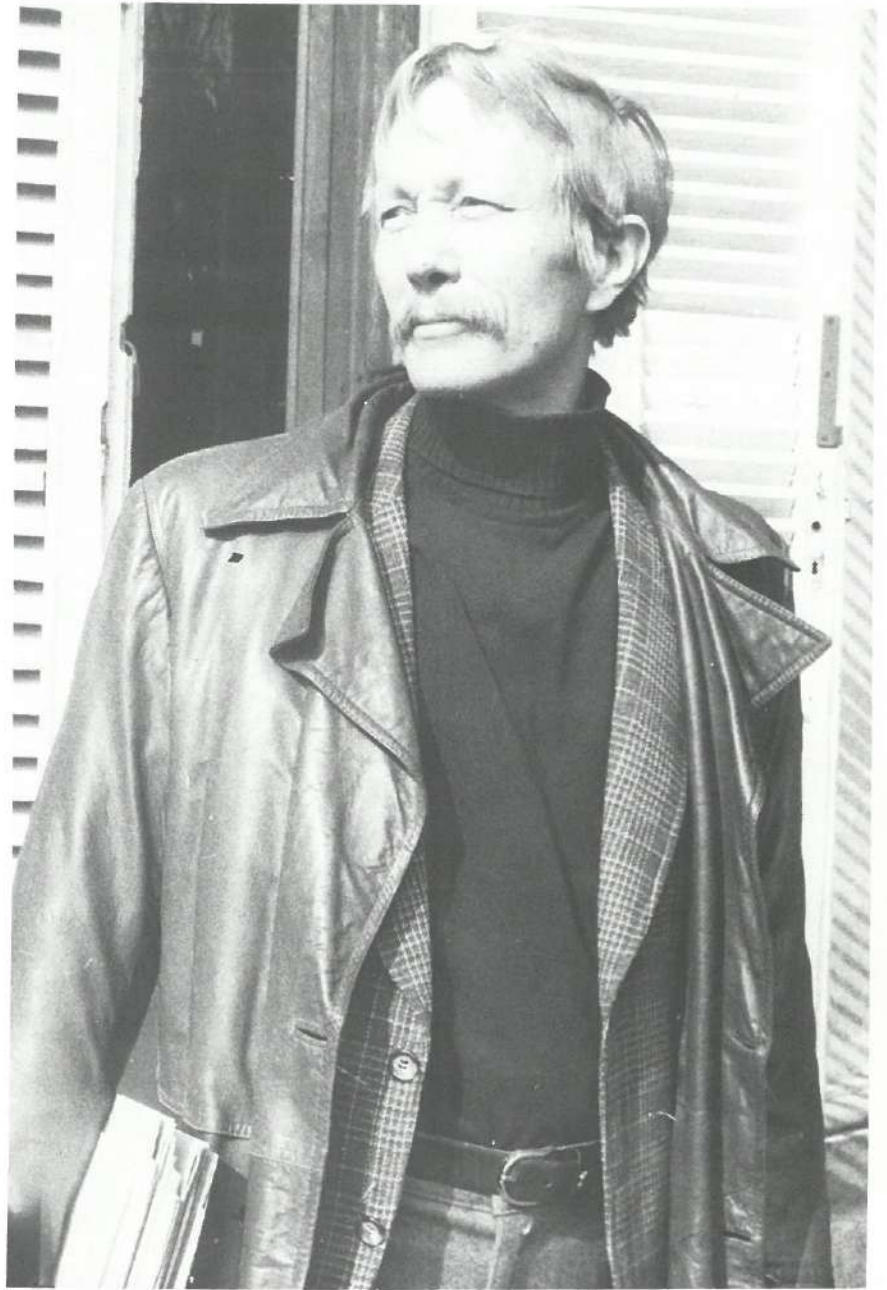
