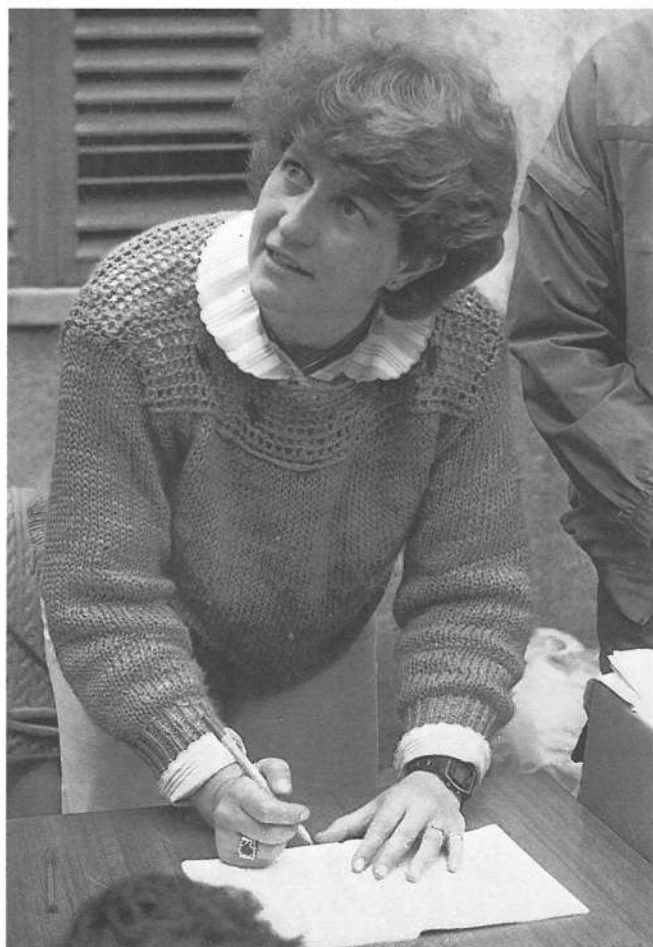

Since ACAT has been privileged to share this special environment during the past ten years we wish to remember Pecetto in this issue of the 1984 Yearbook.

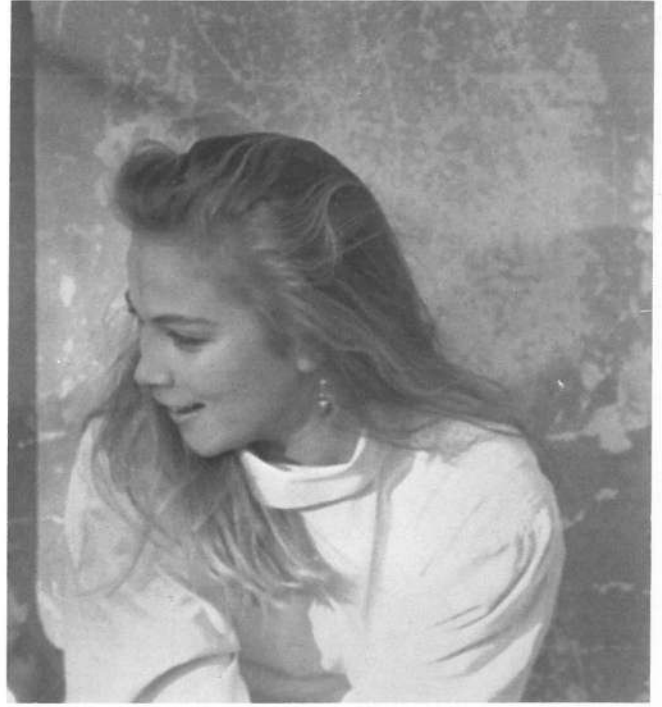
To Elisabetta we dedicate this 1984 Yearbook.
