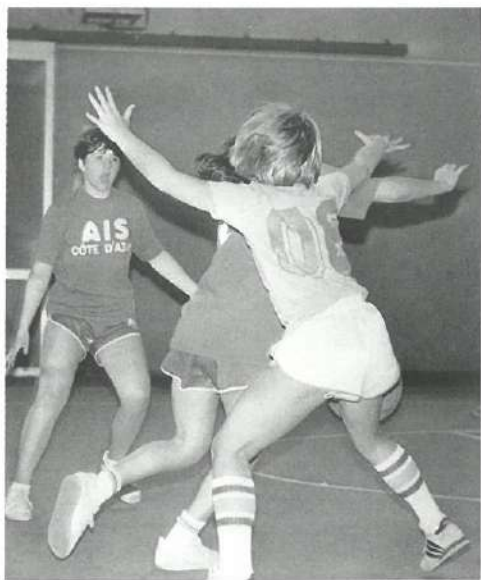

SKI WEEK: a fun-filled, confetti-charged success

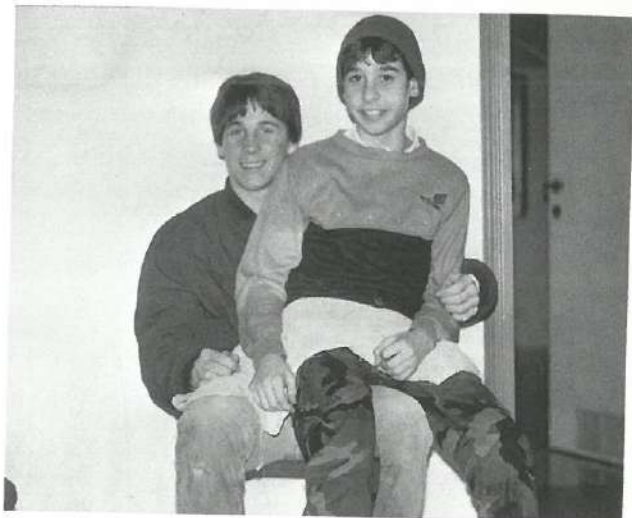
