Have a great summer. I look forward to seeing everyone return next September for more exciting adventures in the middle school.

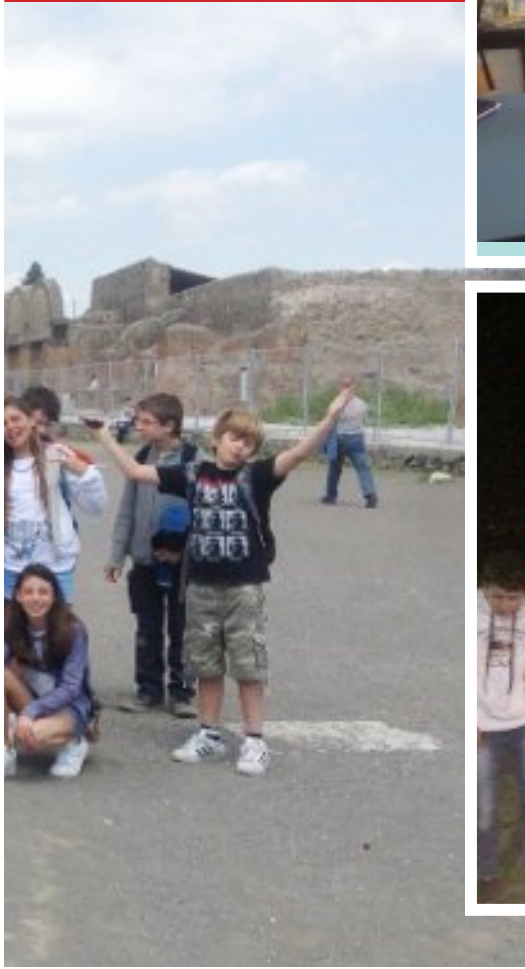

The Eco Club expanded this year into a whole-school club with students from N-12 working together to make the school not just environmentally friendly, but positively regenerative. With the newly formed whole-school Eco Ambassador Program, whose members campaign to make the school an example of a sustainable institution, both the Eco Club and Ambassadors have been working diligently on a range of activities. The Eco Club produces fruit, vegetables and herbs for the school cafeteria. The club also uses the food scraps from the cafeteria for the compost piles and is aiming to make IST a No-Waste School. The compost is then used in the Eco Gardens, building and fertilising soil and so providing chemical free rich nutrients. The Eco Ambassadors were successful in eradicating the wasteful throw-away plastic cups used in the cafeteria and have implemented a monthly 'switch-off' day at IST. The addition of the new raised-garden bed in the piazza is also helping to provide food efficiently for the school's cafeteria.

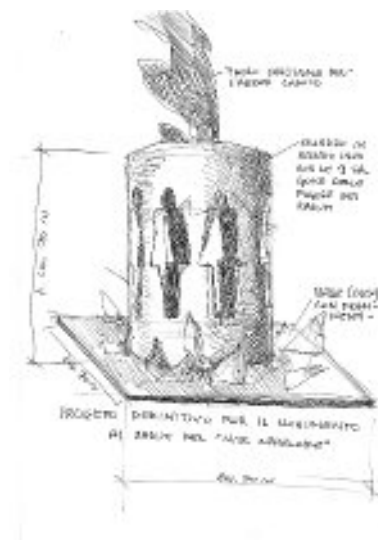




MISS CHARLOTTE PROJECT



During the past year six students have been working on this project that aims at remembering 9 young soldiers who died while sending ammunition and supplies to the Italian partisans that were fighting against the fascist regime. The six students have integrally designed the monument and worked alongside renowned sculptors such as Raffaele Mondazzi and Jessica Carroll.



The monument will be placed on the side of Mount Gran Miol, at 2700 m. above sea level, where the B-17 “Miss Charlotte” crashed on the night of September 11th, 1944.

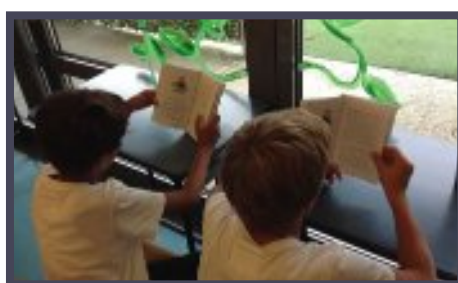


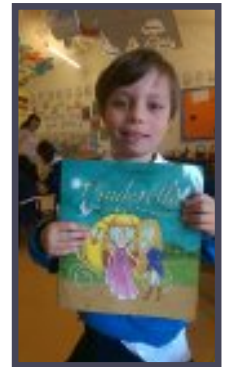
