HEAD OF SCHOOL'S MESSAGE

'Identity' is the theme of this year's IST Yearbook. It is a wonderful choice as it relates so well to the guiding statements of our school. My thanks and gratitude go to the Yearbook team who has produced this fabulous collage of the school year.

In the first semester the faculty worked together to define international mindedness (IM) which is central to all of the IB programmes. Once a draft was created, we consulted with students and parents to see if there was understanding and support for the definition. The IM statement (Respect for the interconnectedness of self, others, cultures and the environment) was well supported and we are now using this statement with the Mission Statement and the IB Learner Profile to guide our work every day.

We often talk about connectedness or belonging; to a family, a group of friends, a place or even a community and how important that the feeling of belonging is to the well being of students. This is exactly where international mindedness begins. It starts with our identity, our self and respect for oneself. IST is a community of learners that has allowed each individual to be who they are, a place that empowers students to be the best they can be. On behalf of the students, thank you to the teaching faculty and staff for creating a positive environment in which our students thrive.

Risk-taking and the desire to achieve one's personal best are very important character traits that we at IST look to develop in all our students.

We aspire to develop young people who have the resiliency and resourcefulness to adapt to and interact successfully wherever they are. Our students have the desire to make a difference for others as true global citizens. They have shone brightly when taking action, be it for sustainability actions through their learning or the Eco Club or through service projects in which our older students have been passionately involved. We must build on these fantastic community connections and instil in all students at IST the value in offering service to others.

IST alumni are always welcome back! To everyone else returning for the 2018-2019 school year, let's make it another year to remember!

A note from the Secondary Principal Mr. John Mores:



The 2017-2018 academic year proved to be very exciting for our Upper School. Once again, our students rose to the occasion as they planned and took part in many important special events. In October, several students led the 2nd IST Student Leadership Summit, at which participants focused on: Immigration: The Duty of Tomorrow's Leaders. As a result of work conducted during the Summit, Mr. Poulus organized IST support for immigrants at SERMIG (SERvizio MISSIONARIO Giovani), which is also known as "The Peace Arsenal." Throughout the year, on a weekly basis, IST students dedicated their time at this facility by sorting donated clothing items/food and tutoring students, thus exemplifying the "caring" attribute of the IB Learner Profile. We thank all the parents, students, and teachers for their work in association with this initiative. Likewise, we thank Mr. Giovanni Bianco for donating the transportation services to support this activity.

The success of this project – which was supported by so many IST community members – indicates how teamwork and determination at IST can yield extraordinary results in our local environment and have a positive impact from an international perspective.

As the year progressed, many students took part in the various Model United Nations events. As in the past, IST hosted the Torino Model United Nations (TOMUN) event. This activity was supported by a record number of students! Thank you to Ms. Walker for serving as the MUN advisor and encouraging IST students as they demonstrated excellent leadership skills in organizing the event.

In January, students took part in the UNESCO Meeting of Young Scientists in Portugal. Dr. Schuering and Mr. McKenzie worked with our young scientists in Grade 11 as they shared the investigations, strategies and actions of IST with

fourteen schools from around the world. The title of the project was “Carbon to Soil -- Taking Actions -- Starting Reactions at IST.” As planned, this project certainly helped strengthen the CAS and ToK elements of the DP core.

In Grade 8, under the direction of Ms. Hahn, students worked to investigate the use of energy in our school and offered suggestions as to how we could utilize our resources more efficiently. It was wonderful to see our students’ enthusiasm for this special project, which was proudly shared with Mr. Coles.

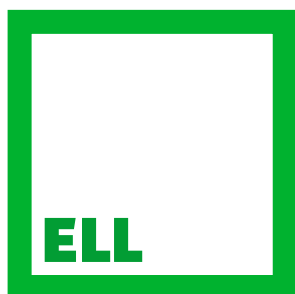
Throughout the year, our Student Council in Grades 6 – 8 made a concerted effort to improve student life at IST. We especially appreciated their work with our PTA in procuring the new ping-pong equipment.

In May, we bid farewell to our graduating students. Several members of the Class of 2018 began attending our school in the Early Childhood Program and made important contributions as they progressed through the Primary Years, Middle Years and Diploma Programmes.

Other students from this class joined IST more recently, but quickly learned the ethos of our school, offering international experience and fresh ideas. We were certainly proud of their achievements, including the IB Diploma Programme exam results which were issued in July. For the past two years, all students who earned the IB Diploma averaged a score of 33. This represents an important achievement, especially considering the inclusive Diploma Programme offered at IST.
